Gateway University Research Park, South Campus

There were no Clery Crimes reported for the Gateway University Research Park, South Campus, in the year 2013.

Hate Crimes

UNCG strives to foster a safe and healthy learning environment that embodies diversity and inclusion of all members of the community. The Hate Crime statistics are separated by category of prejudice. The numbers for most of the specific crime categories are part of the overall statistics reported for each year. The only exceptions to this are the addition of Simple Assault, Intimidation, and any other crime that involves bodily injury that is not already included in the required reporting categories. If a Hate Crime occurs where there is an incident involving Intimidation, Vandalism, Larceny, Simple Assault or other bodily injury, the law requires that the statistics be reported as a hate crime even though there is no requirement to report the crime classification in any other area of the compliance document. Note: a hate and bias related crime is not a separate, distinct crime, but is the commission of a criminal offense which was motivated by the offender's bias. For example, a subject assaults a victim, which is a crime. If the facts of the case indicate that the offender was motivated to commit the offense because of his/her bias against the victim's race sexual orientation, gender, religion, ethnicity, or disability, the assault is then also classified as a hate/bias crime.

There were no reported hate crimes for the year 2011 or 2012.

2013: Three Hate Crimes Reported

- One Vandalism/Destruction of Property incident reported on-campus characterized by racial bias.
- One Simple Assault reported on-campus in a residential facility characterized by sexual orientation bias.
- One Vandalism//Destruction of Property incident reported on-campus characterized by sexual orientation bias.

Dating Violence, Domestic Violence, and Stalking

UNCG offers programs and resources to promote the prevention of dating violence, domestic violence, and stalking. The crime statistics for these offenses are separated by categories of type. The number for most of the specific crime categories are part of the overall statistics reported for each year. The only exceptions to this are the addition of simple assault, intimidation, and any other crime that involves bodily injury that is not already included in the required reporting categories. If dating violence, domestic violence, or a stalking related crime occurs where there is an incident involving intimidation, vandalism, larceny, simple assault or other bodily injury, the law requires that the statistics be reported separately even though there is no requirement to report the crime classification in any other area of the compliance document. Note: a dating violence, domestic violence, or a stalking related crime is not a separate, distinct crime, but is the commission of a criminal offense that involved the additional classification. For example, a subject assaults a victim, which is a crime. If the facts of the case indicate that the offender is dating the victim because of his/her relationship with the victim, the assault is then also classified as dating violence.

2013: Thirteen VAWA Crimes (Dating Violence, Domestic Violence and Stalking Crimes) Reported

- Seven Assault incidents reported in residence halls characterized by dating violence.
- One Assault incidents reported in residence hall characterized by dating violence.
- Two Stalking incidents reported on-campus characterized by dating violence.
- One Stalking incidents reported on-campus characterized by acquaintance.
- One Stalking incidents reported on-campus characterized by stranger.
- One Intimidation incident reported on-campus characterized by dating violence.
